

## **DHHS EPIDEMIC ORDER AND MIOSHA RULES – May 24<sup>th</sup> Update**

On May 24, 2021, the State of Michigan released updated guidance through a DHHS epidemic order and a MIOSHA rules set. The newly issued documents set the parameters for employers and patrons in the workplace.

We recognize that the information provided continues to depend on multiple issues, and there isn't always an easy answer. The rules and guidelines vary based on vaccination status, employee/contractor status, or healthcare setting. The emphasis continues to be on creating a 'safe and effective setting'.

- In most non-healthcare settings, fully vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask unless required by your employer.
- In healthcare settings where patients may be present, fully vaccinated individuals must continue to wear a face covering.
- In all cases, businesses retain the right to require masks of their workers and/or customers.
