

## Implicit Bias Courses

When you register for an Implicit Bias training, make sure it's **interactive**. That means there's an instructor teaching the class while you're taking it, either in person or online, and not just a recording. **OR** it's a self-paced online course where you are interacting with the program and actually engaged in the learning process, not simply reading notes or watching a video.
