The new rules clarify the training standards for identifying victims of human trafficking and add references to the requirements for licensure or renewal contained in other rule sets, such as the Public Health Code General Rules.

The requirements for licensure by endorsement have been reorganized into an easy-to-use chart format, and the rules pertaining to licensure by endorsement and relicensure have been amended to require the applicant to disclose every health care credential the applicant holds and to provide that the applicant must have resolved any disciplinary action taken against the individual before being relicensed or licensed by endorsement.
